

From the Pastor's Desk.....

Today is Easter Sunday, the day when Christ conquers sin and death. Death no longer has a hold over us for he has now proven the permanence of the human spirit. Death is but a door to a new and eternal day.

Normally, our first reading comes from the Old Testament, but beginning today and continuing through the entire Easter season, our first reading comes from Acts of the Apostles. Luke, its author, concludes his gospel with Jesus ascending to heaven. He then opens Acts with Pentecost and the Holy Spirit descending upon the apostles. Luke is the only author to give us a thorough portrait of the early church which he does in Acts.

Today we encounter Peter, but a totally different Peter than the pre-resurrection man. Then he was full of doubt (even on Easter morning), he was constantly putting his foot in his mouth, he fumbled and stumbled more than any other apostle; and now we see the great man of faith, totally transformed by what has happened.

Our second reading from Corinthians is part of Paul admonishing that community about some who had strayed from the truth. Just prior to this reading, Paul deals with a case of a man living openly with his father's wife and Paul tells them to expel him, not for his own sake, but for the sake of all. This is the "old yeast" that must be thrown out and replaced.

All four gospels present Mary Magdalene as the first one at the tomb and later, the first one to whom the Risen Christ will appear. In our account, we're told that John immediately believes when he sees the empty tomb. But not Peter — still slow, stumbling, fumbling, not sure what is going on—he hesitates; but soon he, too, will be

overwhelmed by this incredible event.

Might I take this moment to wish each of you and your families a blessed and holy Easter. This is the day when all of our doubt and hopelessness about life is transformed. Death no longer has a hold over us.

The Parish Office will be closed Mon., March 28.

The Diocese of Erie is certainly not alone in having to face Pastoral Planning and a reconfiguration of parishes. Large archdioceses like Boston, New York, Philadelphia have already undergone massive restructuring. In neighboring Buffalo and Cleveland, scores of parishes have merged. In Chicago, Archbishop Blasé Cupich met with diocesan priests this past week and gave them an overview of what is coming. They anticipate 240 priests being available for 351 parishes by the year 2030. They are now beginning the process we have been undertaking though the scope of theirs is much larger than ours. You can get a glimpse of the magnitude of the closings if you go online and google "St. Adalbert's Church, Chicago, IL—photos." It is one of the parishes slated for reconfiguration. The church, built in 1912, is incredible. It is modeled after St. Paul's in Rome and is a magnificent building. But there are no people left. The buildings are deteriorating, Masses are almost empty. They need \$5 million to stabilize the church towers, another million to get the pipe organ working, etc. Difficult and painful decisions are ahead for everyone, including ourselves.

Choir. While Finance Council is focused on the parish finances, the Parish Council will focus on the life of the parish, ie., how do we involve people to better build a community, to better serve the broader community, etc.

I mentioned several weeks ago that we are interviewing people to do some work on our Stations of the Cross. Those invaluable stations were hand-carved in Munich, Germany over a period of three years by the family of Gabriel Mayer (1892-95). St. Patrick's Church was then designed around them and built in 1906. Some of the wooden bases are splitting, a finger is broken, paint is chipped, etc. They are much too valuable not to care for, and we are getting bids now and interviewing artists who can do the work. I will keep you posted on developments.

Bishop Mitchell Rozanski of Springfield, MA used the Lenten season to tell people who feel unwelcome in the church because of gender, race or sexual orientation that he is deeply sorry and wants to work to make them feel welcome. One person told him "the gay community feels that they aren't welcome. They don't want another religion; therefore, they don't attend church at all." He also heard similar statements from women who said they did not often feel accepted and welcome. "Many people have been treated unkindly, impatiently, or rudely by clergy, religious, ministers and parish staffs, all of which is unacceptable." "I ask your forgiveness," said the bishop as he pledged the entire diocese to become more open and accepting.
