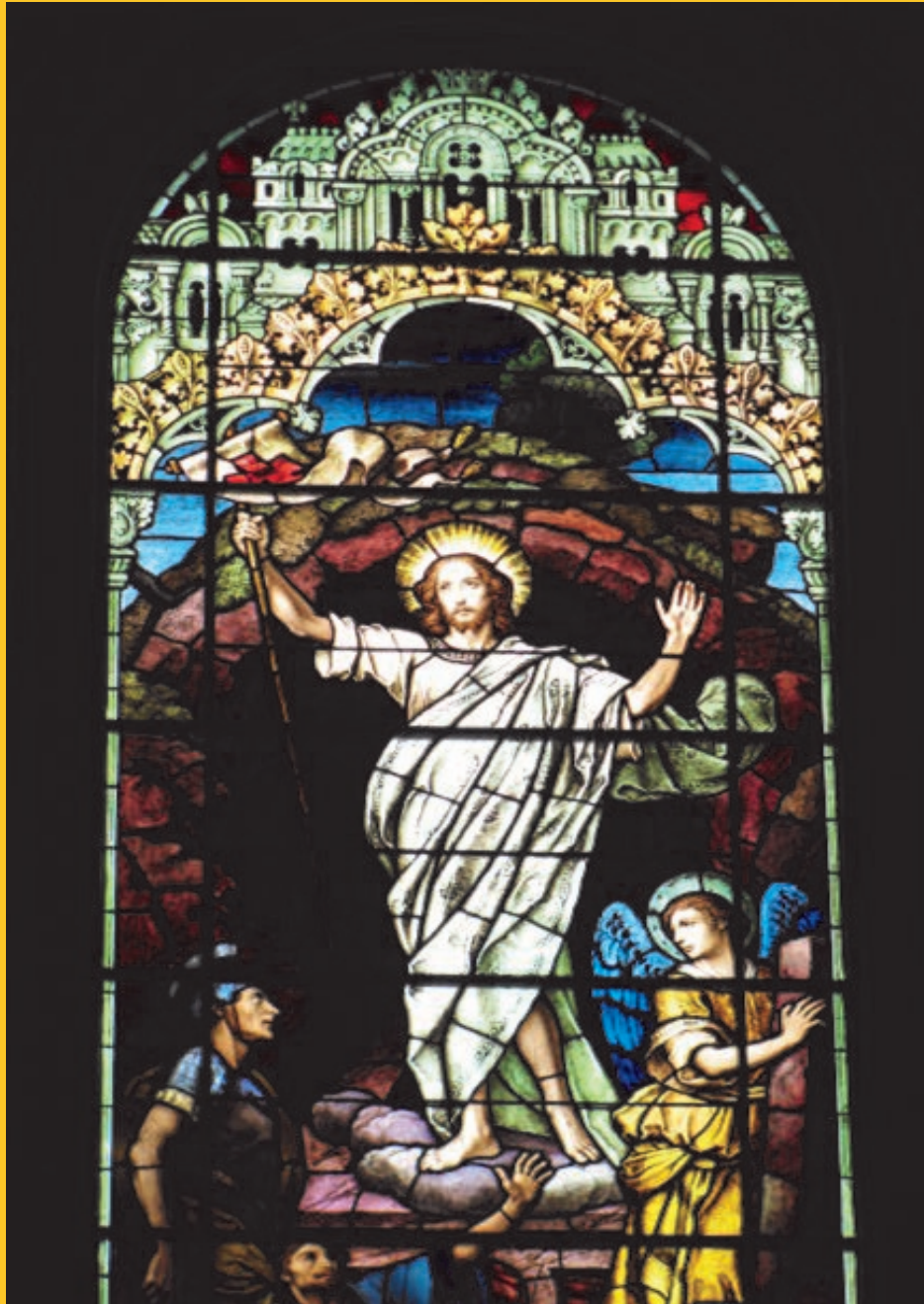

From the Pastor's Desk.....

Today is Easter Sunday and our readings are different for the Easter Vigil and Easter Sunday, but let me focus on the Sunday readings. Beginning today, rather than our first reading coming from the Old Testament, we will read from the Acts of the Apostles. Acts was written by Luke and it takes up immediately after the end of his gospel which ends with the Ascension. Acts opens with Pentecost and chronicles the early church, Paul and Peter. Today is one of the six speeches which Peter gives and are recorded in Acts. Peter is speaking from the house of Cornelius, a Gentile. Peter was very slow realizing that Christ came for all people, Gentile and Jew and the encounter with Cornelius is what helps him open his mind. What Luke has recorded for us is the early church's preaching about Christ. They recognized four steps: his baptism in which God anointed him, his healing ministry, his death and resurrection and finally that Jesus commissioned his apostles to preach and testify to others.

In his letter to the Colossians, Paul has just been visited in prison by Epaphras who founded the church at Corinth. Epaphras tells Paul of false teachers. Paul is writing to get the people back on track. Today's excerpt lays out the ethical consequences of being a disciple of Christ.

Our gospel at the Easter Vigil was Mark's account of the empty tomb; this morning we read John's account. Only in John's version do we hear of Peter and the Beloved Disciple coming to the tomb and the Beloved Disciple deferring to Peter allowing him to be the first to enter. We're told that when Peter did so he "saw and believed," a very important theme in John. John also strongly contrasts believing with understanding as he reports, "they did not yet understand the scripture that he had to rise from the dead."

The Parish Office will be closed on Easter Monday.

Invitations have been sent to all of our lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and ushers inviting them and their spouses for an evening together on Thursday, April 30. By including spouses, this group will total about 75 people. The evening will be an open bar and very heavy finger foods. It's a chance to celebrate what we all do for the parish as well as an opportunity to get to know one another a bit better. I recently chaired a \$3 million capital campaign for the Erie County Historical Society to restore the Watson-Curtze Mansion on West Sixth Street. The results are stunning, and we are going to have the evening at the mansion. People will park here at the church and the trolley will run back and forth all evening as parking is very limited in that neighborhood.

Invitations will be sent out soon to all members of the choir, greeters, Sunday collection counters, and Homeless Shelter leaders and their spouses for a similar evening on Monday, May 11. There are simply too many of us to be able to do it all together. Isn't that a nice problem for a pastor to have!!!

I'm grateful—we all are—to our choir director and organist, Mark Alloway for putting together the music for the Easter Vigil and the Sunday 10:30 Mass. In addition to the choir, we will have pipe organ, trumpet and kettle drums. Before and after the 10:30 Mass, bagpipers will be on the street in front of St. Patrick's Church welcoming you. We are blessed here at St. Patrick's with the quality of our music and the leadership of Mark. These musicians add greatly to our prayer.

To update you on our capital campaign for the restoration of St. Patrick's Church. If you recall, we had pledges of \$1.1 million. To date, \$1,023,000 has been paid and \$101,000 is still to

come in. You may also remember that the final cost of the restoration was \$1.3 million and the committee felt we should proceed and do it right. As a consequence, we will have \$200,000 remaining after all of the pledges are paid, and we plan to pay that from the Catholic Services Appeal as well as from the Irish Festival.

Speaking of the Catholic Services Appeal, at St. Patrick's we presently have pledges of \$ 58,000. If you have not yet made a pledge, can I ask that you consider doing so? With an assessment of over \$45,000, I'm hoping we can generate \$100,000 so that I can apply the balance on the debt from the restoration. Last year we had an assessment of \$42,000 and a goal of \$80,000 which we met. To accomplish this is going to take everyone's cooperation. To date, 116 families have made a pledge out of 754 families in the parish. Can I count on you to help?

Celebrant of the Masses at St. Patrick's next weekend will be Msgr. Richard Sullivan, retired pastor of St. Andrew's.

Bishop Persico and 11 priests gathered for an evening at St. Patrick's rectory recently. Father Mike DeMartinis cooked an Italian dinner that was five star and everyone had a great evening.

We'll start to see a spike in Mass attendance over the next several weeks as the snowbirds return to nest after spending the winter in Florida. This year, I can only say that I envy them.
