



Today we celebrate the feast of our redemption; Christ has conquered death; it no longer has reign over us. During the next 50 days as we move to Pentecost, we will contemplate the post-Easter manifestations of Jesus, the meaning of his death and resurrection in our own lives and our call to be Christ's body through which he continues to touch human pain and heal broken hearts. In our first reading we now encounter a totally different Peter; not the babbling fool who never understands who Jesus is but a man transformed into faith and what he is preaching in this first reading is the basic catechism of the early church. He notes that he and the apostles "are witnesses" which assures Luke's readers that what they hear is exactly what Jesus proclaimed. Peter speaks of Jesus' suffering and death without melancholy because he knows how the story ends: God raised him from the dead. And, finally, he notes that he and the other apostles have been commissioned "to preach the gospel" and he preaches future divine judgment which was important to these early pagans.

Our second reading from Colossians we again hear an extremely early catechism while Paul insists that we MUST "seek what is above."

Try to recall in our gospel, the various author's accounts of the resurrection. John's tomb today has no angels; only an empty tomb that looks like the work of conspirators. It begins with the sober mindset of Good Friday still lingering—darkness, empty tomb, fear. These are all signs to John's story that there has been foul play. There are two clear signs of Peter's significance in that Mary goes first to him and that when he and the Beloved Disciple run to the tomb, the latter waits for Peter to be the first to enter. John peers into the tomb while waiting for the older and slower Peter to arrive. Peter's entry into the tomb and discovering the "rolled up" cloth immediately negates the possibility of grave robbers. Then the other disciple (John, and not the John who writes this Gospel) enters the tomb and says simply that he "saw" and "believed," something not yet attested to Peter. Remember that John actually believes without seeing; it will only be Mary who first sees Jesus. And yet we're told he still did not understand that "he had to rise from the dead," a sign that faith comes in stages.

It's important to remind ourselves that the very fact that these early authors would assign such an important role to a woman (remember the patriarchal society in which they lived) is clear evidence that women played a very significant role in Jesus' life, death and resurrection. We'll see later how very uncomfortable Paul is with this fact; but we cannot deny that Jesus embraced women, had them as disciples, assigned them as the only ones to stand at his cross in 3 of the gospels, that a woman is the first to discover the tomb and will be the first to whom the risen Jesus appears. It might seem insignificant to us; but in that patriarchal society, this was earth shattering.

Throughout the diocese we continue our annual Catholic Services Appeal, and I hope you will consider a pledge if you have not already done so. Funds generated in this appeal finance the education of our seminarians, help care for the retired priests, fund the Marriage Tribunal and a multitude of other offices which serve the parishes. Our goal this year at St. Patrick's is \$42,350 to pay the assessment and at St. Hedwig's \$11,803. I hope to raise significantly more than that at St. Patrick's so we can use the extra to help pay down the debt on the restoration. To date we have pledges at St. Patrick's for \$56,335.00.

The Parish Office will be closed on Easter Monday.

We are now beginning the wedding season at St. Patrick's and, with the exception of one weekend, we have a wedding every weekend from May 1 through Thanksgiving. It's great to see all of these young couples coming here to pledge themselves to each other for life. As part of their preparation, they each take a testing tool called FOCCUS which seems to be an incredibly effective tool to help them improve communication skills between themselves. The couples themselves give great feedback on the test. In addition to that and the paper work preparation which we have to do, Mark Alloway (our organist) and Jan Gervasi (our wedding coordinator) meet with the couple to plan their music, ceremony, etc. I also invite all of the couples in for a relaxed evening at the rectory. I invite 4 to 5 couples at a time, drinks at 5:30, dinner at 6:30. It's a totally relaxed evening and a chance to get to know them better and hopefully an opportunity to make them feel

welcome in the parish.

I'm hoping to find a couple of St. Patrick parishioners who might be willing to construct a 20' x 20' stage for our festival. We're hoping it can be built in sections that can link together so that we will be able to easily store it during the year. Holy Trinity Parish is gracious enough to lend us their dance floor so we don't have to worry about that. The stage is 20' x 20' and one foot high. If interested, please contact the parish office. Festival will purchase all of the materials. If we had to rent both of these each year it would cost us over \$1,500 per year.

Congratulations to St. Patrick parishioner, Jamie Power, who is finishing his second year of theology studies at St. Mary's Seminary, Baltimore, and has been assigned to St. Joseph Parish in Warren, under the direction of Father Rich Toohey. Jamie will be ordained a priest for our diocese in May 2016.

Catholic Services Appeal




